Napa Valley Wine Library Association Celebrates its 50th Anniversary with an Outstanding Lineup



Meet the new vintners of the Napa Valley at our “Toast to the Future: the Next Generations”

On Saturday, August 18 at the Culinary Institute of America at Greystone in St. Helena, a dozen vintners will present their wines as they discuss the challenges and opportunities family wineries present, and how the wines embody their responses. Second, third, even fifth generation vintners will focus on daily operations, the vineyards or the winery, with Q&A's after each panel discussion moderated by Allen Balik.

After the seminar an informal lunch from Bouchon Bakery will be served in the gardens of Spottswoode in St. Helena, where the Association's Annual Tastings were held from 1966 until 1970. An informal tasting and Spottswoode Estate wine accompany lunch. An optional tour of the adjacent vineyards and winery of Spottswoode Estate, celebrating its 40th anniversary, rounds out the day.
